Ephesians 2:8-10

Introduction:

Big idea: We are saved by faith alone, but the faith that saves is never alone.

I. By grace, through faith. Eph. 2:8

II. Not saved by a principle of works. Eph. 2:9

III. Created for good works. Eph. 2:10

Questions for reflection:

- How does the rejection of boasting before God (v.9) rule out the principle of works?
- What place should 'good works' have in the life of a believer?
- As you examine your own life, do you see the evidence of your salvation in the form of good deeds?
- How might you grow in your service to God and others?
